The St. Mary's congregation and wardens wanted to share the following with you. Saturday's front-page headline in the Ottawa Citizen "First Split for Ottawa Anglicans" implied that the entire congregations of the Anglican churches in Navan Bearbrook and Vars had decided to break away from the Ottawa Anglican Diocese. While it is true that the rector, the Rev. Alex Lewanowicz, has resigned and some members of Vars and Bearbrook' congregations have left, many church members including the entire congregation of St. Mary's Navan (the largest of the three) have opted to remain. It is very important to note that while this situation is regrettable it has been developing for some years and is hardly the major split that has been reported. Though we fully recognize that there are some fundamental disagreements within the Anglican Church of Canada our opinion is that these should be worked out through dialogue and discussion within the church rather than by attempting to split the church apart. In addition we remain as friends with those who have left, and fully respect the integrity of the Rev. Lewanowicz. The congregations of Navan Bearbrook and Vars remain viable, active and welcoming and are fully part of the Anglican Diocese of Ottawa.

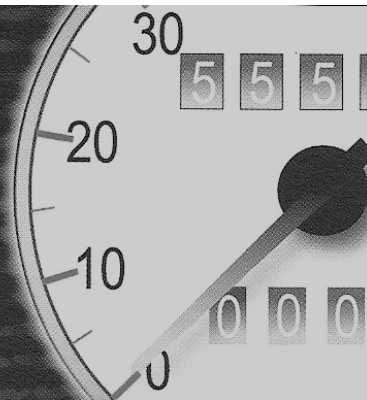

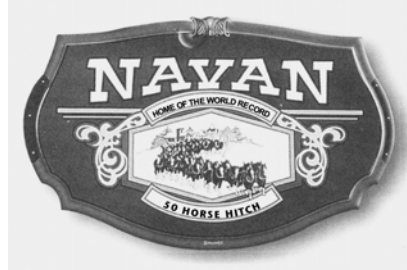
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NAVAN COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION

-Any physical confrontations will result in immediate expulsion (by contacting parents) and a ban from future NCA dances.

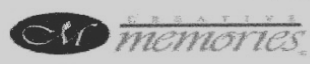
-No parents are allowed on the dance floor unless escorted by a NCA volunteer – no exceptions.

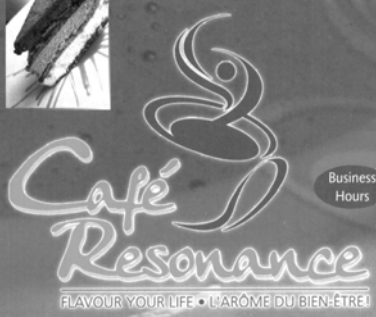

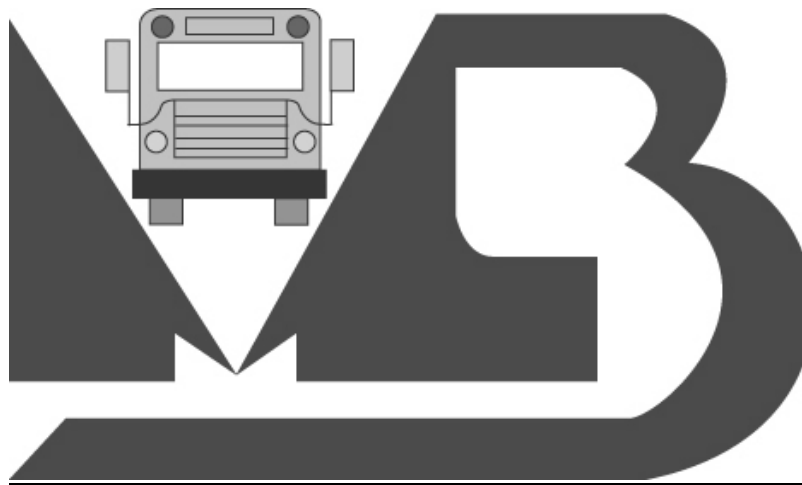

Bringing recognition to her door in many awards and accolades.

This octogenarian you could say, had a wonderful life,
