Andrea is a young Navan woman who recently received the Orleans Online Outstanding Youth Award. As well, she was the recipient of the Cairine Wilson Leadership Honour. During her years at high school, Andrea eagerly took on leadership roles. She was President of the Student Council at Cairine Wilson Secondary School. This position gave her opportunities to organize much school wide and community projects. She initiated school spirit challenges, a fashion gala for Juvenile Diabetes, school clothing campaign and many more activities for the students of her school. She was also a member of Students On the Leading Edge (S.O.L.E.).

She was the coordinator of a Team Relay for Life, a cancer fundraiser that raised over \$28,000.00 for cancer research!! Andrea was also responsible for media relations and recruitment of cancer survivors for this 12-hour walk. She also took part in the annual clean up at Christie Lake Camp. I found this young woman to be excited about her community, keen to help others in need, and not afraid to do the necessary hard work that is involved in helping others.

In her community, she was Secretary for the Russell Junior Farmers. She taught Sunday School at St. Mary's Hall in Navan. In 2006, she organized students from all the Ottawa Schools, to answer phones for the CHEO Telethon. That must have been quite a challenge! She also volunteers at the General Hospital.

On the international level, Andrea is an active member of the Nelson Mandela Children's Fund. She coordinated a youth conference on Parliament Hill and was its Master of Ceremonies. She was active in establishing a sister school in Eastern Cape, South Africa for Cairine Wilson High, in Orleans. A shipment of school supplies, sports equipment, and clothing for this South African school was sent to that school. How fortunate this sister school was to have Andrea in charge of this effort.

Presently she is enrolled at the University of Ottawa in Political Science. Good luck in your studies Andrea. Keep up your efforts to make this world a better place for

everyone to live in. We are fortunate indeed to have you residing in Navan.

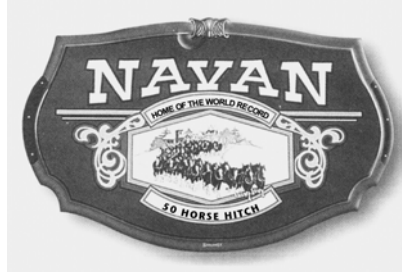

June 16th NCA meeting will have a guest speaker from the Friends of the Mer Bleue to give a 30-minute talk on what has happened in the last year about the development of the Navan Waste Management Site.



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The Animal Care and Control By-law No. 2003-77 [pdf

] provides for a variety of regulations related to dogs including leashing, maximum number permitted per household, registration, removal of waste, etc.

What does the by-law say?

- All dogs must be registered with the City.
- Registration must be renewed every year, no later than April 30.
- City issued tags must be securely affixed to the dog's collar or harness at all times.
- Replace lost tags immediately. Replacement tags are free of charge.
- Only three (3) dogs over twenty (20) weeks of age may be kept in a residence unless the premises is a licensed kennel, an accredited veterinary facility or a registered facility for temporary foster care.
- Dogs are not allowed to run at large and must be kept under the control of their handler at all times when off their property.
- Stray dogs may be impounded at the Ottawa Humane Society and a fee must be paid in order to claim your pet.
- Dogs must be on-leash at all times when off their property, unless posted signs indicate otherwise, or they are in a securely fenced private yard.
- The leash may not exceed three metres (3m) in length.
- Dogs are not allowed within five metres (5m) of:
 - a play structure,
 - a wading pool, or
 - a spray pad
- You must pick up all waste produced by your dog both on and off your property.
- It is an offence to permit your dog to bite or attack without provocation, a person or domestic animal.
- A dog that has bitten or attacked may be required to wear a muzzle.
- Provincial law prohibits anyone from owning, breeding, transferring, importing, fighting or abandoning "pit bulls" in Ontario. The definition of a "pit bull" under the Act includes: pit bull terrier, Staffordshire bull terrier, American Staffordshire terrier, American pit bull terrier or a dog that has an appearance and physical characteristics that are substantially similar to any of the aforementioned dogs. **Have a question or concern? A reminder to Navan residents: all dogs must be on-leash at all times when off their property, as per the City of Ottawa By-Law, No. 2003-77. This INCLUDES the former CP rail line, which is private property, although commonly used as a pathway.

On Wednesday, May 21st, in the afternoon, a resident was walking their dog along the abandoned railway and did not

have their small dog on a leash. The dog left the pathway and entered private property, bordering the pathway.

Within this private property, were several head of purebred beef cattle and their calves. The dog began aggressively chasing the cattle and could not be controlled by the owner. Luckily, the owner of the property heard the commotion and intervened, but had to make several attempts to stop the dog from continuing to chase the cattle. In the meantime, the cattle were very distressed and were trying to protect their calves. The dog owner was on private property, without their dog on a leash and was unable to control their animal.

While it is a very nice pathway and residents are encouraged to get out and enjoy our wonderful Navan community, as owners of the cattle and also a dog owner, we would ask that all residents comply with the City of Ottawa By-Law, as well as respect the private property of others. When we walk our dog up in the village, she is always on a leash, and we would expect the same respect.

Dogs often have never seen cattle and owners can never predict how they will respond to these large animals. The cattle, in turn, will protect their calves, and will also become very distressed by the chasing, which can cause them to abort their unborn calves. This is not an isolated incident and has happened in the past, as well. In this case, we were lucky that none were injured but we do not want a next time. Thank-you, Ivan & Kathy Matthews.



TRAFFIC

I believe the message was to post no trespass signs on private property; they (the riders) are not permitted to ride on private property unless they have written consent from the owner, which they must carry on their person. They have to be 100% positively identified for us to be able to investigate and possibly charge. Identity is hard because of helmets etc... If a license plate is found we can make inquiries however they are also hard to get and we must be able to ascertain who the operator was. 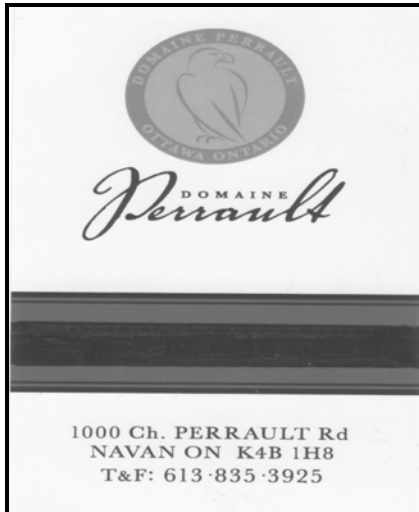

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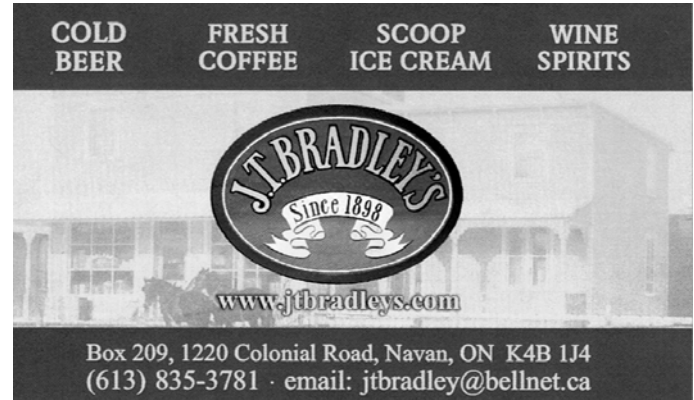
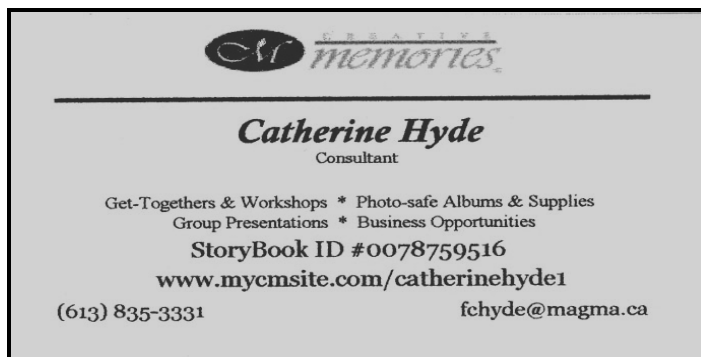
Garden Tour In Navan

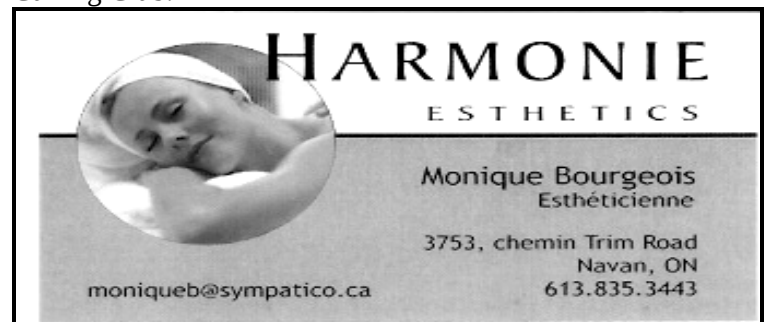

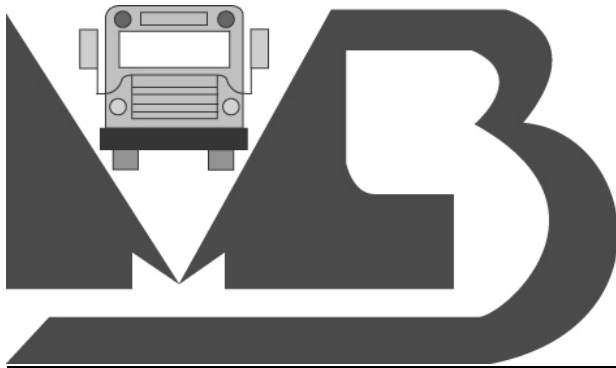
