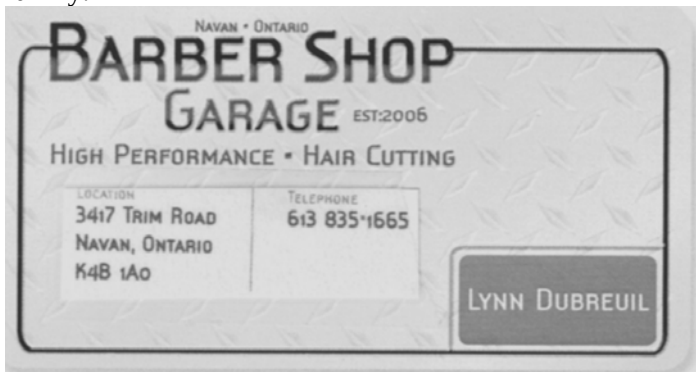

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NOTICE to residents that there will be road closures for some events during the Navan Fair.

Saturday Aug. 9th Traffic will be diverted away from Smith Road and Colonial Road from 11am to 1pm due to the Parade.
Sunday Aug 10th for the Bed Race

Traffic traveling East will be rerouted off Smith Road on to Forest Lea, Sunnydale, Fairgreen then on to Colonial Road

Traffic traveling South on Trim will be rerouted off Trim Road on to Henn Drive and then on to Colonial Road

PARKING restrictions have been imposed by the Fire Department on **Fairgreen** to parking only on the North side from Trim Road to the Gate and NO parking from Colonial Road to the Gate to allow for emergency vehicles to enter the Fairground in case of an emergency.

Parking on Delson will be restricted to the West side only but NO parking for 200 feet on both side at Colonial Road and the Gate entrance to allow for the safe turning in and out of large vehicles.

Extra policing by the use of bikes and patrol cars has been arranged during nighttime hours for the streets of Navan during the Fair

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HOME TIP OF THE MONTH

CPR made easier (Heart & Stroke website press release March 2008)

The new hands-only approach is aimed at bystanders who witness a sudden cardiac arrest outside a hospital setting. If you see an adult suddenly drop over, be quick to do the following:

1. Have someone **call 911 immediately**, or do it yourself.
2. With the patient flat on their back, place the heel of one hand on the center of the chest and the other hand on top of the first. Lock your elbows and perform fast, forceful **chest compressions at a rate of 100 per minute**, lifting your hands slightly after

each push to allow the chest to recoil. Take turns with a partner - if one is available and continue until paramedics arrive.

3. If an automated external defibrillator is available, attach it to the patient and follow the voice prompts. Otherwise keep compressing the chest.

Hands-only CTP should not be used for infants or children, for adults who cardiac arrest is from respiratory causes (such as drug overdose or drowning) or for unwitnessed

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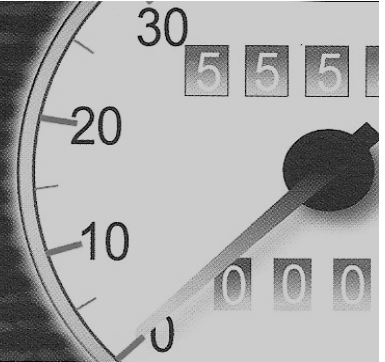

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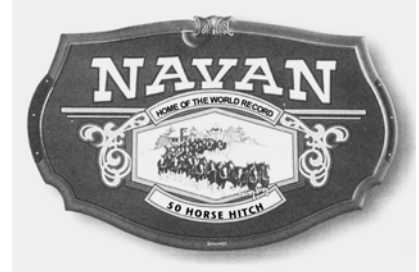

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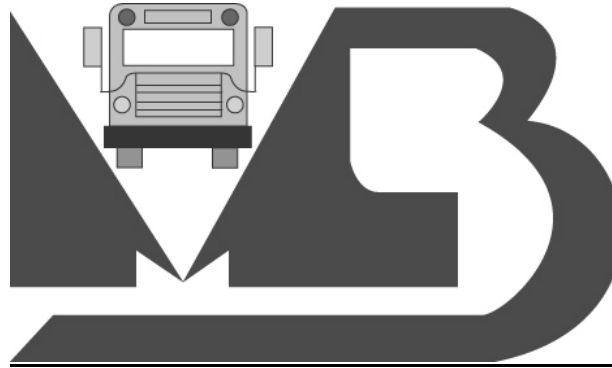
