**CENOTAPH SOD TURNING CEREMONY**  
 Things have changed for the Cenotaph Sod Turning Ceremony from what you read in the Nugget's July issue. It will be held on Tuesday, August 17<sup>th</sup> at 11:00 am. Rob Jellett our City Councillor will be present as well as many from the C.T.A.S. Board of Directors and the Navan Community Association. Everyone is invited to come and witness the beginning of this historic event which is happening this summer and fall here in Navan. Construction on the restored and relocated Navan Cenotaph begins immediately after the sod turning ceremony. The construction period is expected to last for 6 or 7 weeks. It should be a great daily destination point for all the walkers around town as you will be able to see the progress of the Cenotaph unfurl in Navan Memorial Park.

## PUBLIC NOTICE FOR RESIDENTS OF THE VILLAGE OF NAVAN

The Cumberland Township Agricultural Society would like to advise you in advance of planned street closures during some of the 2010 Navan Fair activities.

On Saturday, August 14<sup>th</sup> the traditional Fair Parade will take place. Participants will congregate in the field off Smith Road just south of Meteor Street. The Parade commences approximately at 11:00 am which will proceed along Smith Road east to Colonial, crossing over Trim and continuing east on Colonial until Delson. The Police and volunteers will be directing motorist and spectators as the Parade proceeds along its route.

On Sunday, August 15<sup>th</sup> is the Navan Fair Bed Race which will leave from the Royal Bank Parking lot (3435 Trim) south to the corner of Smith and Colonial Roads, turning left on to Colonial to J.T. Bradley's Country Convenience store parking lot (1220 Colonial Road). The Bed Race will commence at 11:30 am run until 12:30 pm, therefore traffic will be redirected off Trim Road at Henn and then east on to Colonial Road. Funds raised will be donated to Canadian Cancer Foundation.

Restricted parking signs will be posted on Fairgreen and Delson for emergency access to the Fair grounds and livestock trailers specifically on Delson. 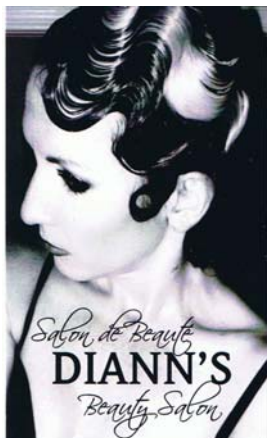

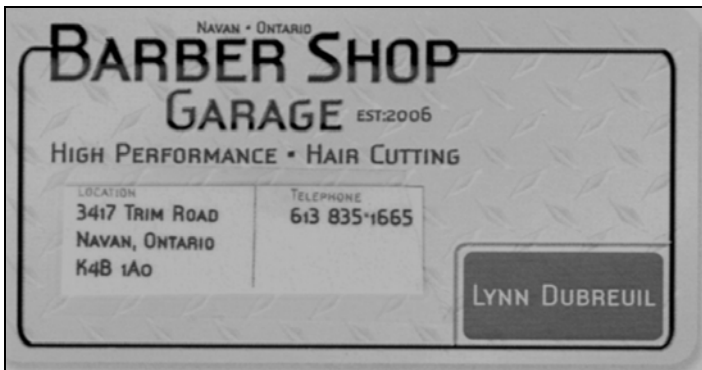

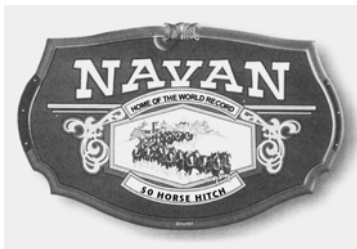

Please take the time to familiarize yourself with what is being proposed in our community, attend the meeting, and provide your comments to the MOE. 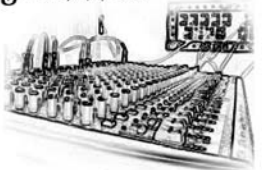

## HOME TIPS OF THE MONTH

### How to Get Rid of Earwigs in House?

Most homeowners, when they see earwigs in house, have common queries in mind like 'are earwig bugs dangerous' or 'are earwigs harmful to humans'. The unusual name earwig is given from the belief that it enters through the ears of sleeping people and makes its way to the brain. From its name, many people keep wondering about entry of earwig in ear and residing inside it. This is not the case, though it is very scary to see groups of earwigs in house. Following are some earwig removal tips that you can follow:

- Earwigs get attracted to moist and damp areas in the house. Hence, make sure you clean such places and keep them dry as far as possible. Give special attention to the foundation sites that usually remain moist.
- A common entry point of earwigs in house is through ground level windows. To prevent their infestation, consider installing well-fitted window screens and regular weather stripping.
- Like windows, doors also serve an entrance gate for earwigs in house. You should keep a strict watch over cracks and abnormal fitting of doors. Correct the malfunctions by following do-it-yourself options like caulking, weather stripping and cementing.
- In case of severe earwig infestation or if you notice a large colony in home corners, get a vacuum cleaner and vacuum them immediately. Ensure that you do it quickly, otherwise they are fast to react and will scatter within a few seconds. Also, remove eggs (if any) and discard them in a sealed container.
- Another natural method of killing earwigs in house is using **boric acid** powder. Place it in corners where you think earwigs are present or hiding. Within 1 - 2 weeks, you can succeed controlling earwigs in house.
- Vinegar is a good repellent for earwigs. So, you can think of wiping entrance sites, doors and windows with concentrated vinegar solution. After smelling vinegar, earwigs will migrate to outdoors.

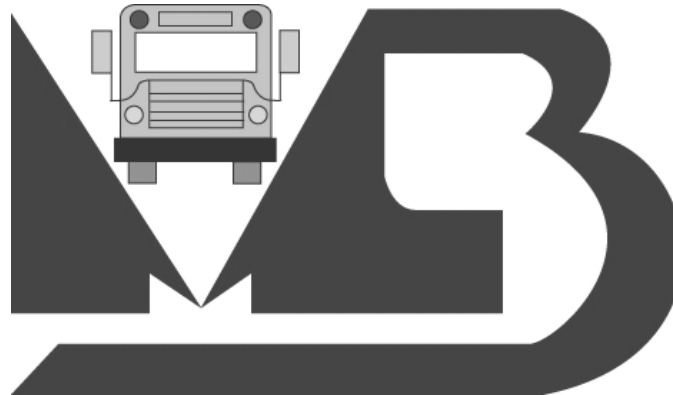
