NAVAN'S OUTDOOR RINK IS COMING SOON!

Work on Navan's new outdoor skating rink has already begun! A group of volunteers got together on Sunday, November 25th to lay the groundwork for Navan's new outdoor rink, which will be located in the Domes area of the Navan Fair Grounds.

The purpose of the outdoor rink is to provide an opportunity for local families to have greater access to an ice surface for pick up hockey and recreational skating. Weather permitting, the committee is hoping to have the new skating rink open for the Christmas holidays.

As mentioned in the last issue of the Nuggett, the congregation of St. Mary's Anglican Church, presented a small locally made Celtic cross in maple to our Navan2Navan guests during their visit. This maple cross was made to celebrate the 150th anniversary of Navan, Ontario. In 1973, when St. Mary's celebrated its 75th Anniversary, St. Mary's, Navan, Eire presented us with a similarly designed cross in peat bog oak. The new maple cross, copies of which have been placed in Holy Trinity Bearbrook and St. Andrews Vars, differs from the original peat bog cross in having a central Trillium design. On presenting the cross, we asked if it could somehow be shared by Catholic and Anglican St. Mary's churches in Navan, County Meath. This was asked for two reasons – one being that we knew there was a close collaboration between both churches and we wanted to honour that relationship, and secondly most of the people who were our guests were in fact members of the Catholic St. Mary's. The selection of woods is also symbolic— maple of course stands for Canada, and bog oak – thousands of years old and likely from a tree which predated Christianity— symbolizes the antiquity and depth of the civilization that we inherit from our European forbears. The maple crosses were made by Bob Kelms of Cumberland.

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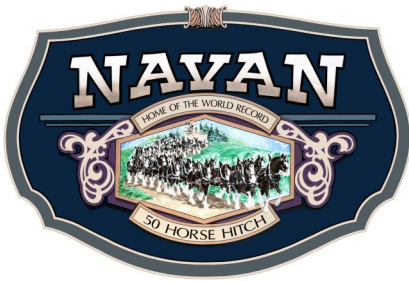

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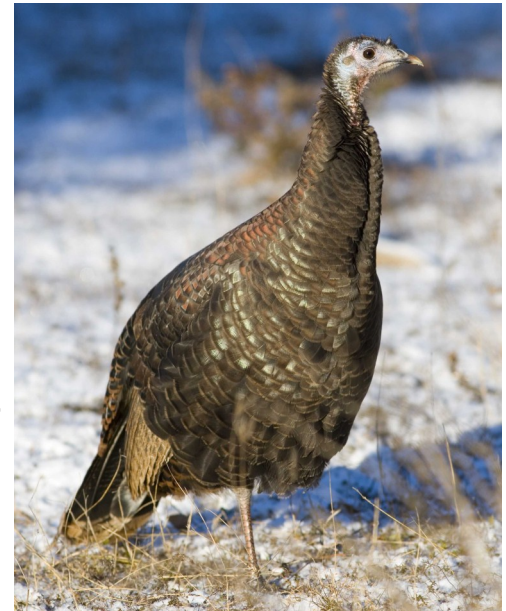
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Wild Turkeys

As it is nearly Christmas it seems relevant to talk about Turkeys, and as you may have noted, we have a group of roaming wild Turkeys in Navan - one of which appears to be an albino - you may have seen it. The Navan flock is often to be seen in the fields especially around Cotton's farm. Although native to North America, the Wild Turkey got its name due to the trade routes in place in the 16th Century. Oddly, the major trade route from the Americas and Asia required the goods to go via Constantinople before being sent to Britain. The British therefore associated them with Turkey and the name stuck. Despite their weight, wild turkeys, unlike their domestic counterparts, are agile fliers. Their ideal habitat is an open woodland or savannah, where they may fly beneath the canopy top and find perches. They usually fly close to the ground for no more than a quarter mile (400 m). Wild turkeys are omnivorous, foraging on the ground or climbing shrubs and small trees to feed. They prefer eating acorns, nuts, and various trees including hazel, chestnut, and hickory, as well as various seeds, berries such as juniper and bearberry, roots and insects. They like to eat any remaining dried-on-the-branch crab apples in early winter but may munch on amphibians and small reptiles. The Navan turkeys are rumoured to have paid a rather destructive visit to the Perrault Winery. By the early part of the 20th Century the population of the Wild Turkey became dangerously low, but reintroduction programs begun in the 1940s have been very successful. The birds were reintroduced to areas where populations had declined but which contained recovering woodlands. Wild turkeys are now abundant and their presence here in Navan is beyond their accepted range which has its northern boundary at the St Lawrence Seaway.
